Médecins Sans Frontières in Pakistan

Ten weeks after the floods first hit Pakistan, 125 international staff are still working alongside nearly 1,200 Pakistani staff in MSF's flood response and pre-existing programmes in Pakistan. Following the floods MSF set up an emergency response to provide aid to affected people.

In southern Sindh MSF's medical teams face problems of diarrhea and skin diseases, to dealing with symptoms stemming from the stress of losing homes, difficulty getting food and safe water, and generally unhygienic living conditions in camps and shelters.
